

ORDINANCE NO. 131
AMENDING
ORDINANCE 114 AND 97

LICENSE SCHEDULE

TO FIX AND PRESCRIBE A LICENSE SCHEDULE FOR THE TOWN OF MAPLESVILLE, ALABAMA, AND THE POLICE JURISDICTION THEREOF, UPON THE HEREINAFTER ENUMERATED VOCATIONS, PROFESSIONS, BUSINESSES, TRADES OR CALLINGS FOR THE YEAR 2006 AND EACH SUCCESSIVE YEAR UNTIL AMENDED OR REPEALED, EXCEPT HEREINAFTER PROVIDED:

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MAPLESVILLE, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That every person, firm, company, corporation or association who shall engage in any business, vocation, occupation, profession, trade or calling hereinafter enumerated or who shall exercise any privilege hereinafter described for which a license or privilege tax is required within the corporate limits or police jurisdiction of the Town of Maplesville, Alabama, shall first procure from the Clerk of the Town of Maplesville for the exercise of said privilege the amounts hereinafter provided and in addition shall, where required make such reports and give true statements of the gross amounts of business done upon which such license or privilege tax may be determined, and shall comply with the provisions of the ordinance.

SECTION 2: There is hereby levied for the use of the Town of Maplesville, Alabama, on the hereinafter enumerated businesses, vocations, occupations, professions, trades or callings which may be maintained, operated, carried on, or engaged in by any person, firm, company, corporation or association, or who shall exercise any privilege hereinafter enumerated within the corporate limits or the police jurisdiction of the Town of Maplesville, the following licenses or privileges tax for the year beginning January 1, 2006, and for each year thereafter, until amended or repealed; provided, however, that for the protection of the lives, health and property of the citizens within the police jurisdiction of the Town of Maplesville, Alabama, and without the corporate limits thereof, and for the maintenance of the corporate limits thereof, and for the maintenance of good order and quiet of the community and preservation of public morals and not for revenue; there is hereby levied a license tax on each business, trade or profession engaged in or carried on, within the police jurisdiction of the Town of Maplesville, and without the corporate limits of said town, of one-half of the amounts hereinafter enumerated and set forth, to wit:

1. ABSTRACTS: Furnishing, making or preparing abstracts of title to lands, Per Year \$30.00
2. ACCOUNTANTS OR AUDITORS: Each person engaged in business as an accountant or auditor or any person preparing, advising or making income tax returns or other tax returns as an agent for another reward, Per Year \$50.00

3. ADVERTISING: Each person, firm or corporation engaged in the business on a temporary or transient basis of soliciting business over the telephone or otherwise with no fixed place of business in the Town of Maplesville, Per Year \$30.00
4. ADVERTISING-COMMERCIAL: For soliciting, contracting for, preparing, accepting compensation for advertising matter by persons, firms, or corporations having an office or place of business within the Town of Maplesville and not otherwise paying a town license, Per Year \$30.00
5. AMBULANCE: Each person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of furnishing ambulance service, other than as a part of the business as undertaker, Per Year \$30.00
6. AMMUNITION: Each dealer in pistol or rifle cartridges or shotgun shells, Per Year \$10.00
7. ASSISTED LIVING CARE: Each person, firm or corporation operating an assisted living care facility for profit, Per Year \$75.00
8. ATTORNEY-AT-LAW: Each, Per Year \$50.00
9. AUCTION HOUSE: Each person, firm or corporation selling or offering for sale goods to be sold to highest bidder, Per Year \$75.00
10. AUTOMOBILE ACCESSORIES: Per Year \$40.00 (Provided that said person is not subject to retail merchants license)
11. AUTOMOBILE, TRUCKS, TRACTORS AND TRAILERS (EXCEPT MOTORCYCLES):
 - (A) Each dealer in new motor vehicles, trucks, tractors, and trailers, Per Year \$75.00
 - (B) Each dealer in used motor vehicles, trucks, tractors, and trailers not paying a license as a dealer in new motor vehicles, trucks, tractors and trailers, Per Year \$75.00
12. AUTOMOBILE TIRE RETREADING: Each retreading or tire repair shop, Per Year \$50.00
13. AUTOMOBILE WASHING, Not in connection with another licensed business: Per Year \$50.00
14. AUTOMOBILE WRECKING SERVICE: Each person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of furnishing automobile wrecker service other than persons paying a garage or automobile repair shop license, per wrecker Per Year \$75.00

15. AWNING: Each person, firm or corporation who makes or installs awnings, Per Year \$30.00

16. BAKERY AND BAKERY PRODUCTS:

- (A) For operating a mixing plant or baking plant for the product of baking products generally with the privilege to distribute the same by wholesale or retail, Per Year \$75.00
- (B) Selling, delivering, distributing or supplying bakery products by vehicle whether wholesale or retail, Per Year \$50.00

17. BANKS: Each banking establishment where the capital, surplus and undivided profits are:

- (A) \$50,000.00 or less, Per Year \$10.00
- (B) More than \$50,000.00 and not over \$100,000.00
Per Year \$20.00
- (C) More than \$100,000.00 and not over \$150,000.00
Per Year \$30.00
- (D) More than \$150,000.00 and not over \$200,000.00
Per Year \$40.00
- (E) More than \$200,000.00 and not over \$250,000.00
Per Year \$50.00
- (F) More than \$250,000.00 and not over \$300,000.00
Per Year \$60.00
- (G) More than \$300,000.00 and not over \$350,000.00
Per Year \$70.00
- (H) More than \$350,000.00 and not over \$400,000.00
Per Year \$80.00
- (I) More than \$400,000.00 and not over \$450,000.00
Per Year \$90.00
- (J) More than \$450,000.00 Per Year \$100.00

The term “undivided profits” as used in this ordinance shall be construed to mean the profits as shown by the bank and all payments shall be based on the report made by the bank to the superintendent of banks of Alabama, next preceding January 1, of the current year.

18. BARBECUE STAND OR SANDWICH SHOP: without tables or booths, Per Year \$50.00

With tables and booths: See Restaurants

19. BARBER SHOP: Each Barber Shop chair as follows:

(A) First Chair, Per Year \$35.00

(B) Each Additional Chair, Per Year \$15.00

20. BEAUTY SHOP: Each person, firm or corporation engaged in the operation of a Beauty Shop:

(A) First Operator, Per Year \$35.00

(B) Each Additional Operator, Per Year \$15.00

21. BILLARD ROOM OR POOL ROOM: Each person, firm or corporation engaged in the business, calling or profession for the operation of a billard room or pool room, shall pay a privilege license therefore of \$75.00 Per Year for the first table and \$25.00 Per Year for each additional table or similar apparatus or device upon which billards or pool is permitted or played. Provided, however, that no license will be issued without first obtaining consent of the Town Council.

22. BLACKSMITH SHOP: Per Year \$25.00

23. BOARDING HOUSE: Each person who operates a transient boarding house, Per Year \$50.00

24. BOND AGENT: Each person, firm or corporation making or furnishing appearance, surety, appeal or other judicial bonds for a consideration, Per Year \$50.00

25. BOOKS OR BOOK STORE SUPPLIES: Each transient dealer in each, Per Year \$50.00

26. BOOKS OR PAMPHLETS: Canvassing for, selling, offering for sale or delivering books, pamphlets, Per Year \$50.00

27. BOOTBLACK: Polishing shoes on streets or in other places, Per Year \$25.00

28. BOTTLED DRINKS: Each RETAIL DEALER in soft drinks or bottled drinks who does not pay a soda fountain license, Per Year \$15.00.

A dealer shall not be required to pay a bottled drink license if all bottled drinks are sold through a vending machine.

29. BOTTLED DRINKS: Each person distributing, delivering, selling or handling soft drinks, whether retail or wholesale, by motor vehicle, Each Vehicle \$75.00 (Provided that said person is not subject to retail merchants license)
30. BOTTLERS: Each person, firm or corporation operating a plant where soft drinks are bottled or manufactured, Per Year \$75.00
31. BOX BALL OR BOWLING ALLERY: Each alley as follows:
 - (A) First Alley, \$50.00
 - (B) Each additional alley, \$30.00 (No license will be issued without consent of Town Council.)
32. BUS TERMINAL: Each person, firm or corporation operating, maintaining or engaged in the operation of a bus terminal, bus station, waiting room, ticket office or other conveniences in connection with the carriage of passengers for hire, Per Year \$50.00
33. CABINET MAKER: For each cabinet maker, woodworking shop or other shops for manufacturing or repairing of wood products, Per Year \$50.00
34. CABLE T.V., Per Year \$75.00
35. CANDY OR CANDY PRODUCTS:
 - (A) Each manufacturer of candy or candy products, Per Year \$50.00
 - (B) Each truck, car or motor vehicle used in selling, delivering or distributing candy or candy products, Per Year \$35.00
 - (C) Each wholesale or retail dealer in candies who does not pay a merchants license or does not manufacture his products in the Town of Maplesville, or who does not pay license for distributing candy or candy products by truck or other motor vehicle, Per Year \$35.00
36. CARNIVAL OR STREET FAIR: Per Week \$300.00 (Provided, however no license will be issued without first obtaining consent of the Town Council)
37. CARPENTERS, PAINTERS, MASONS, ETC.: Each person engaged in the business or following the trade or profession as a carpenter, painter, mason, etc., Per Year Residential \$30.00 Non Residential \$50.00
38. CATTLE DEALER: Each person, selling, offering for sale or trading cattle, sheep, goats, hogs etc., Per Year \$10.00 (Persons selling cattle, sheep, etc., of their own raising are not subject to this license)

39. CELL PHONE SERVICE: Each person, firm or corporation that erects a tower or receiver for use of providing cell phone service, Per Year \$75.00
40. CHICKENS AND EGGS: Each person who deals in, sells or ships chickens or eggs to persons outside the Town of Maplesville, in crates or boxes, who does not pay a merchants license, Per Year \$25.00
41. CIGARS, CIGARETTES, TOBACCOS AND SNUFF:
- (A) Each wholesale dealer, Per Year \$50.00
 - (B) Each retail dealer, Per Year \$10.00; A retail dealer shall not be required to pay this license if all tobacco products are sold through a vending machine.
42. CIRCUS: Each, Per Week \$300.00 (Provided, however, no license will be issued without first obtaining consent of the Town Council)
43. CLOTHING AND WEARING APPAREL:
- (A) Selling, soliciting orders for, taking measurements, fittings or delivering men's or ladies' wearing apparel where such agent or company is not carrying on a licensed or established place of business in the Town of Maplesville, Per Year \$75.00
 - (B) Selling from house to house, offering for sale, distributing or delivering of men's or ladies' wearing apparel from a motor vehicle, Per Year \$75.00
44. COAL, COKE, OR FIRE WOOD DEALER: Maintaining or operating a coal, coke or wood yard or distributing or selling coal, coke or wood in the Town of Maplesville, Per Year \$50.00
45. COFFINS AND CASKETS: See Undertaker
46. COLLECTING AGENCY: Each person, firm or corporation other than Attorney-At-Law engaged in collecting general accounts each, Per Year \$50.00
47. COMMISSION MERCHANT: Every person who sells goods, wares, merchandise or other property for a compensation shall be deemed a commission merchant within the meaning of this schedule, Per Year \$50.00
48. CONCERTS OR OTHER MUSICAL ENTERTAINMENT: Where admission is charged, except for charitable, educational, or religious purposes, Each Performance \$30.00

49. CONTRACTORS, GENERAL: Any person other than the owner who shall undertake to assume authority or control, or who has assumed authority or control, or who supervises, manages, or directs the work of others or who is delegated by the owner to do so; in the erection, construction, alteration or repair of any building structure or construction project of any nature or character, or any part thereof, whether done by special contract or in connection with or incidental to building or repair work, Per Year \$50.00
50. CORN GRIST MILL: Each, Per Year \$30.00
51. COTTON BUYER: Each, Per Year \$50.00 (Not subject to half year rate)
52. COTTON GIN: Each, Per Year \$50.00 (Not subject to half year rate)
53. COTTON MILL: Each, Per Year \$75.00
54. COTTON SEED MEAL OR HULLS: Each person dealing in cotton seed meal or hulls, who does not pay a merchants or cotton gin license, Per Year \$30.00
55. DANCE HALL: Each Per Year \$100.00 (Provided, however, no license will be issued without first obtaining consent of the Town Council)
56. DAY CARE AND/OR NURSERY SCHOOL: Per Year \$50.00
57. DOCTORS: Including Dentists, Chiropodists, Chiropractors, Opticians, Optometrists, Physicians, Veterinarians, or other persons engaged in similar businesses, occupations or professions, Each Per Year \$75.00
58. DRAYS, CARTS, WAGONS: Hauling, delivering and contracting for hire or reward, Per Year \$30.00
59. DRIVE-IT-YOURSELF COMPANY: First Car \$30.00 and Each Additional Car, Per Year \$10.00
60. DRY CLEANERS AND/OR PRESSING:
- (A) With an established place of business in town, Per Year \$75.00
 - (B) Soliciting and picking up dry cleaning in town, Per Year \$50.00
(Not having an established place of business in town)
61. ELECTRIC LIGHT COMPANIES: Each person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of selling or distributing electrical current, shall pay the Town of Maplesville an amount equal to 3% of the gross receipts for the business transacted by such person, firm or corporation in the Town of Maplesville for the preceding year from the sale of electrical current sold or distributed from any point or points in the

Town of Maplesville by such person, firm or corporation for any purpose whatsoever. Each person, firm or corporation shall pay to the Town of Maplesville 1 and ½ % of the gross receipts for the preceding year for business transacted by such person, firm or corporation outside the corporate limits, but within the police jurisdiction, of the Town of Maplesville.

62. ELECTRIC OR NEON SIGNS: Any person erecting or servicing electric or neon signs, Per Day \$10.00; Per Week \$25.00; Per Year \$50.00
63. ELECTRICAL SUPPLIES: Each dealer in electrical supplies who does not pay a merchants license, Per Year \$75.00
64. ELECTRICIANS: Any person who contracts for, solicits, engages in or follows the trade or profession of repairing or installing electrical fixtures, wiring, air conditioning, or appliances, Per Year \$75.00
65. EXPRESS COMPANIES: Each person, firm or corporation doing business as express company, commercially engaged in business in the Town of Maplesville and receiving and sending packages to and from any other point in the state, not including revenues derived from interstate commerce, Per Year \$75.00
66. EXTERMINATORS: Each person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of extermination of insects and rodents of all kinds, Per Year \$75.00
67. FERTILIZER:
 - (A) Each wholesale or retail dealer in fertilizer who does not pay a wholesale or retail merchants license, Per Year \$75.00
 - (B) Each person receiving, storing, delivering, and distributing fertilizer by truck or other motor vehicle, Each Vehicle, Per Year \$75.00
68. FIREWORKS: (Not Prohibited by State Law) Per Year \$75.00
69. FISH AND OYSTERS: Retail dealers, not in connection with another licensed business, Per Year \$30.00
70. FLORIST: Each florist or dealer in flowers, plants or shrubbery in the Town of Maplesville, Per Year \$75.00
71. FORTUNE TELLERS, CLAIRVOYANTS, ASTROLOGERS, MEDIUMS, PHRENOLOGISTS: And all other persons practicing palmistry, clairvoyance, mesmerism, and hypnotism, and all other persons using devices for the purpose of telling fortunes, and all spiritualists giving sittings or exhibitions, Per Week \$75.00

72. FOUNDRY AND MACHINE SHOP: Per Year \$75.00 (This license does not authorize the repair of automobiles, trucks, tractors, trailers or motorcycles)
73. FREIGHT AND/OR PRODUCE DELIVERY: Each person, firm or corporation or motor transportation company who unloads, delivers, distributes or disposes of any goods, wares, merchandise or products in the Town of Maplesville, Per Year \$75.00
74. FREIGHT DEPOT AND/OR TERMINAL: Every motor propelled contract carrier doing business in the Town of Maplesville by maintaining depots, stations, terminal facilities therein or by receiving passengers, baggage or freight for hire from said Town of Maplesville, Per Year \$75.00
75. FRUIT, NUT, AND FARM PRODUCE: Each person engaged in the sale of fruits, nuts and farm produce:
- (A) Each retail dealer who does not pay a merchants license, Per Year \$50.00
 - (B) Each person selling and delivering wholesale to retail merchants, Per Year \$50.00

A dealer in fruit and/or farm produce of his own raising shall not be required to pay any license for the privilege of selling such fruit and/or farm produce at retail from any truck or wagon on the public streets, and all fruit and produce sold in the Town shall be strictly conformity with the health and sanitary ordinances of the Town and the laws of the State of Alabama.

76. GARAGE AND AUTOMOBILE REPAIR SHOP: Each garage or automobile repair shop for the repair of automobiles, trucks, trailers, tractors, or motorcycles employing three mechanics, helpers or less, Per Year \$75.00
- Employing more than three mechanics or mechanics helpers, Per Year \$75.00
77. GAS, BUTANE, OR OTHER GAS IN CONTAINERS: Any person selling, delivering, distributing, servicing butane or other gas in containers:
- (A) Persons with an established place of business in the Town of Maplesville, Per Year \$75.00
 - (B) Persons that do not have an established place of business in the Town of Maplesville, Per Year \$75.00

78. GASOLINE:

- (A) Each person, firm or corporation or dealer who sells, disposes of, distributes or delivers gasoline, kerosene, or motor oils in the Town of Maplesville, by pipe, truck, or other vehicle, Per Year \$75.00

- (B) Each person, firm, or corporation operating a retail gasoline service station, Each Pump or Filler Stand, Per Year \$15.00

79. GOLF COURSES: Miniature or otherwise, Per Year \$75.00

80. GRAIN AND FLOUR DEALERS: Each wholesale or retail agent or broker of grain, hay, flour or feedstuff maintaining a warehouse, depot or place of business in the Town of Maplesville, or the police jurisdiction thereof, who does not pay a wholesale or retail license, Per Year \$75.00

81. GUN REPAIR SHOP: Per Year \$30.00

82. HORSES AND MULES: Each person, firm or corporation who deals in horses or mules, who maintains a permanent place of business, Per Year \$75.00

83. HOTEL: Each, Per Year \$75.00

84. ICE: Each person, firm or corporation manufacturing, selling or delivering ice in Maplesville, Per Year \$30.00

85. INSURANCE:

- (A) FIRE AND MARINE: Each fire and marine insurance company, four dollars on each one hundred dollars or major fraction thereof of gross premiums less returned premiums received on policies issued during the preceding year on property located in the Town of Maplesville.

- (B) EACH INSURANCE COMPANY OTHER THAN FIRE, MARINE, AND FRATERNAL: \$10.00 plus one dollar on each hundred dollars and major fraction thereof of gross premiums less returned premiums, received during the preceding year on policies issued during said year to citizens and residents of the Town of Maplesville.

All licenses due under this schedule and the next succeeding schedule shall become delinquent if not paid on or before sixty days from January 1, of the year in which they are due. On all such delinquent licenses there shall be due and collected an additional sum equal to 20% of the original amount of the license. Failure of any such insurance company to furnish the statement required by section 736 of Title 37 of the 940 Code of Alabama, and to pay the amount shown thereby to be due the Town of Maplesville for license for the current year, on or before sixty days from January 1, of the year in which such license becomes due, shall cause a forfeiture of the right of the company so failing of it's agents to continue to do business in the Town of Maplesville until said statement shall have been filed and said sum with penalty thereon as herein provided shall have been

paid and shall subject the company and it's agents to the penalties prescribed by this ordinance for doing business without a license.

86. JEWELRY: Each person selling or offering for sale on the streets or going from house to house selling or offering for sale any diamonds, rubies, sapphires, pearls, opals, emeralds or other precious stones or high grade standard jewelry, Per Month \$50.00
87. JEWELRY: PEDDLERS OF CHEAP JEWELRY or persons keeping stands on the streets or other places for the sale of cheap jewelry, Per Year \$30.00
88. JEWELRY: PURCHASES OF: Itinerant purchasers of old gold or other precious metals or old jewelry, Per Month \$20.00
89. JUNK DEALERS: Each dealer in scrap iron, rags, hides, waste paper and like materials, Per Year \$50.00
90. LAUNDRIES AND COIN-OPERATED LAUNDRIES:
 - (A) Having an established place of business in town, Per Year \$75.00
 - (B) Soliciting and picking up laundry in town, not having an established place of business in town, Per Year \$75.00
91. LAWCARE SERVICES: Each person, firm or corporation who cuts grass, trims hedges or does any kind of lawn care service, Per Year \$50.00
92. LINEN, TOWEL AND UNIFORM RENTAL SERVICE:
 - (A) Where linen, towels, uniforms, cleaning rags and similar articles are furnished in connection with or as a part of a general laundry business upon which a license has been paid to the Town of Maplesville, Per Year \$50.00
 - (B) Not in connection with a laundry business, Per Year \$50.00
93. LOG, TIMBER, OR LUMBER MERCHANTS: Each dealer engaged in buying, receiving, storing, distributing, or shipping logs, timber, cross ties, pulpwood, wood chips either for himself or as an agent (Not in connection with a planning mill or sawmill), Per Year \$75.00
94. MANUFACTORY, FABRICATING OR PROCESSING PLANT: Each person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of manufacturing, fabricating or processing, by hand, machinery, or otherwise, wares or materials of any kind, not otherwise specified in this ordinance:
 - (A) Employing less than 5, Per Year \$30.00

- (B) Employing 6 but less than 15, Per Year \$50.00
- (C) Employing 15 but less than 25, Per Year \$100.00
- (D) Employing 25 but less than 40, Per Year \$150.00
- (E) Employing 40 or more, Per Year \$200.00

95. MEAT MARKET: Not paying a merchants license, Per Year \$75.00

96. MEDICINE AGENT: Each person or agent selling, delivering or soliciting orders for patent medicines, who does not pay a druggist license, Per Year \$75.00

97. MERCHANT, WHOLESALE OR RETAIL: Each person, firm or corporation doing business as a wholesale or retail merchant not otherwise stated herein, Per Year \$75.00

98. MINI STORAGE: Each person, firm or corporation who for a fee provides a place for storage of goods, Per Year \$75.00

99. MONEY LENDERS OR MONEY BROKERS:

(A) Pawn Brokers maintaining and operating an established place of business in Town for lending money or accepting pawns, except a regularly organized bank, Per Year \$75.00

(B) Not maintaining an established place of business in Town, Per Year \$75.00

100. MONUMENTS AND TOMBSTONES: Each person, firm or corporation who sells, solicits orders for, or erects monuments or tombstones, Per Year \$75.00; Per Day \$10.00

101. MOTORCYCLES: Dealers in new or used motorcycles or motorcycle accessories, one or both Per Year \$50.00

102. MOVING PICTURE SHOWS: Each moving picture theater, Per Year \$50.00

103. MUSIC MACHINES:

(A) Each person, firm or corporation leasing, setting up, distributing, servicing, lending or placing on commission any coin operated music machine, commonly known as Rockola or Victrola or any other coin operated musical instrument, Per Year, Per Machine \$25.00

(B) Each person, firm or corporation operating a coin operated music machine, Per Year \$15.00

Such license shall be issued to the person, firm, corporation in whose place of business such machine is operated and the license shall not follow the machine to any place of business other than where the machine is originally licensed.

104. NEWS AGENT: Each agent, person, firm or corporation distributing newspapers which are distributed from house to house to subscribers, Per Year \$30.00
105. NEWSTAND: Each dealer in magazines, newspapers and periodicals, Per Year \$25.00
106. NURSERY AND LANDSCAPING: Each person, firm, or corporation engaged in the business of selling or delivering shrubbery, plants or other nursery stock, Per Year \$75.00
107. OILS, KEROSENE, ILLUMINATING OIL OR GREASE:
 - (A) WHOLESALE DEALERS, Not paying a service station license, Per Year \$50.00
 - (B) RETAIL DEALERS, Not paying a service station license, Per Year \$30.00
108. PEANUT OR POPCORN TOASTERS OR WARMERS: Persons not paying a merchants license, Per Year \$25.00
109. PEDDLERS: Each peddler of goods, wares or merchandise, Per Year \$50.00 (Not otherwise paying a town license)
110. PHOTOGRAPHERS:
 - (A) Each maintaining as office in town, Per Year \$75.00
 - (B) Each transient, Per Day \$25.00
111. PLANING MILL: Each person, firm, or corporation operating a planing mill, Per Year \$75.00
112. PLUMBING, GAS FITTING: Each person, firm, or corporation engaged in the business of plumbing, gas fitting, steam or water heating, Per Year \$75.00

Provided that no license shall be issued for the operating of loud speakers on the streets or sidewalks until written application is made to the Town Clerk and this application granted.

115. RADIO, TELEVISION, TAPE PLAYERS – DEALER: Each dealer in radios, televisions or tape players or similar electrical devices, not paying a merchants license, Per Year \$75.00
116. RADIO, TELEVISION, TAPE PLAYERS – REPAIR: Each person, firm, corporation engaged in the business of repairing or servicing radios, televisions, tape players and similar electrical devices, Per Year \$75.00
117. RAILROADS: Each person, firm, or corporation operating a railroad in the Town of Maplesville, as a common carrier, for the privilege of doing interstate business within the limits of said Town of Maplesville, whether such company is incorporated or not, Per Year \$75.00
118. REAL ESTATE AND REAL ESTATE LOANS: Each person, firm, or corporation, who shall offer for sale, advertise for sale, or sell, or offer for rent, or rent, for compensation any property other than their own; or negotiate a mortgage loan or real estate, on commission or who appraises real estate for others, Per Year \$75.00
119. RESTAURANT: Each person, firm, corporation operating a restaurant, café, cafeteria or lunch stand where tables or booths are provided whether in use or not, Per Year \$75.00
120. SATELLITE SALES: Each person, firm or corporation selling or installing satellite systems, Per Year \$45.00
121. SAWMILL: Each person, firm, or corporation operating a sawmill, Per Year \$75.00
122. SEPTIC TANKS: Any person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of cleaning or installing septic tanks,

136. UNDERTAKERS: Each undertaker or dealer in undertaking supplies, Per Year \$75.00

VENDING MACHINES: Each person, firm or corporation who possesses, operates or maintains for the operation by others any coin operated vending machine for vending gum, candy, cigarettes, soft drinks, popcorn, or any kind of foods except peanut products or any other article, and any coin operated weighing machine:
- (A) Machines requiring 10 cents or more, Each Machine, Per Year \$15.00
 - (B) Machines vending only peanuts, peanut butter sandwiches and/or peanut products, Per Year \$15.00
 - (C) Game machines, Per Year \$20.00
139. VENEER MILL AND/OR PLYWOOD MANUFACTURER: Each Per Year \$75.00
140. WAREHOUSES: For the storage of goods or produce of any kind, Per Year \$30.00
141. WATCH REPAIR: Each watch repairman, Per Year \$30.00
142. WHOLESALE DEALER, BROOKER OR COMMISSION MERCHANT: Not specified elsewhere in this ordinance. Each person, firm, or corporation or dealer in, or agents soliciting orders for, any merchandise, flour, groceries, tobaccos, fresh meats, or any other packing house products at wholesale to merchants of the Town of Maplesville and delivering the same by motor truck, Each Per Year \$75.00
143. WRECKER SERVICE: Each Per Year \$75.00
144. MISCELLANEOUS: All other business, professions, occupations or callings not herein specified, Per Year \$75.00

SECTION 3: When used herein, the term "Person" means and includes an individual, firm, corporation, partnership, company, agency, association or agent for another.

SECTION 4: EXEMPTION

No license shall be required of any doctor, dentist, physician, lawyer, engineer, or any engaged in a similar profession. The two year exemption herein provided shall date from the first admission to practice no matter where such first admission takes place.

SECTION 5: STATEMENTS REQUIRED WHERE LICENSE DEPENDS ON GROSS RECEIPTS

In all cases where the amount to be paid for license depends upon the capital invested or value of goods or stocks or amount of sales or receipts, it shall be the duty of any person applying for such license to render to the town clerk, a sworn statement of such capital, sales or receipts of business, of the volume of such stocks or goods and further proof as the town clerk shall demand to show the actual capital invested, value of goods or stock and said clerk, shall not be required to receipt for any money until such proofs are furnished. The amount of merchandise returned for taxes as evidenced by the current tax books may be deemed by the clerk as 60% of the amount on which the license shall be computed.

It shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly and willingly make a false written affidavit as to the amount of the stock on hand or volume of gross receipts. Revenue or business or amount of capital invested in business or number of employees or vehicles used, or seating capacity, or to file such affidavit with the town clerk, or any license collector for the purpose of defrauding the Town of Maplesville or by procuring a license for a less sum than is lawfully due by affiant or his principal.

SECTION 6: LICENSE YEAR - PENALTY FOR DELINQUENCY

The license year of the town shall begin on the first day of January of each year and shall end on the thirty-first day of December of each year; and each license issued under the authority of this article whether issued on or after the first day of January of the year for which it is issued, shall expire on the thirty-first day of December of that year.

All licenses issued under the authority of this article shall be issued for the calendar year during which the same are issued and shall be issued upon payment of the respective amounts herein prescribed therefore; provided, however, that any license issued after the first day of July of the calendar year for which it is issued may be issued upon payment of one-half (1/2) of the amount of the annual license tax required for the subject of such license, except that the foregoing provision shall not apply to licenses based on gross receipts, which licenses shall be based upon the actual amount of the gross receipts for such period as hereinafter provided, and any other classifications as herein specified.

All privilege license taxes levied herein shall be due on January the first of each year and shall be delinquent on the following February the first, except that insurance licenses levied herein shall not be delinquent until the following March the first. In the event any license levied herein shall not be paid before the same has become delinquent there shall be added thereto a penalty as follows:

That a penalty of ten percent (10%) of the amount of license shall be charged on all licenses not paid within thirty (30) days from the date and becomes due, and

That a penalty of fifteen percent (15%) of the amount of license shall be charged on all license not paid within sixty (60) days from the date same becomes dues, and

That a penalty of twenty-five percent (25%) of the license shall be charged on all license not paid within ninety (90) days after the date same becomes due,

Except upon proof being furnished that any business or occupation has not been commenced or engaged in prior to date of application thereof.

Provided: That on all exhibitions, trades, businesses, vocations, occupations, and professions other than insurance of all kinds, commenced on August 1, a penalty of 10% of the amount of license shall be charged on all licenses not paid within 15 days from the commencement of said business, and a penalty of 20% on all licenses not paid within 30 days from the commencement of said business.

Provided further: That a penalty of 10% of the amount of license on all licenses for each kind of business of a movable character, such as automobiles for hire, auto trucks for transportation of freight, drays, hacks, hucksters, fruit peddlers of all kinds: coal and wood peddlers, oil peddlers, junk peddlers, fruit peddlers, street photographers or itinerants, or transients or occupation engaged in, by persons not having a regular and established place of business in the town, not paid on or before the February 1, each year, and that a penalty of 15% of the amount of license shall be charged on all license of such movable business or occupation has not commenced or engaged in prior to the date of application therefore: provided, however, that this shall not prevent the license inspector from collecting which are due and delinquent after January 1.

SECTION 7: TRANSFERABILITY

That no license issued under this ordinance shall be transferred except with the consent of the Town Council and no transfer shall be valid until endorsed by the Town Clerk and no license shall be transferred more than once and never from one business to another.

SECTION 8: LOCATION

That any person desiring to engage in any business for which a license is required by this ordinance, shall designate the place of business and only be authorized to carry on the business under said license at the place as designated unless given permission to transfer to another location by the Mayor of the Town.

SECTION 9: TOWN CLERK TO ISSUE

That any license issued hereunder shall be dated and signed by the Clerk of said Town for any service rendered in issuing the license, the Clerk shall receive the sum of \$5.00 to be paid by the person or firm procuring the license.

SECTION 10: ENGAGING OR DEALING IN TWO OR MORE BUSINESSES

That any person, firm, or corporation dealing in two or more articles or engaged in two or more businesses or callings for which a license is required of each such person shall pay for and take out a license for each business or calling.

SECTION 11: ENGAGING IN BUSINESS WITHOUT LICENSE PROHIBITED

That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation or association to engage in any business vocation or profession for which a license is required wherein without first paying for and taking out said license, and on each day during which person or corporation engaged in business without a license shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 12: PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS OF ORDINANCE

Any person, firm or corporation or association who shall violate provisions of any portion of this ordinance shall upon conviction be fined but not less than \$1.00 and not more than \$100.00 and may also be sentenced to hard labor for not more than 6 months at the discretion of the court trying the case.

SECTION 13: SIDEWALK SALES

The taking out of a license under this ordinance shall not be authority for the person obtaining same to engage in any business on the streets, sidewalks, avenues, vacant lots, or alleys of the Town of Maplesville, Alabama; and no person shall use the streets, avenues, sidewalks, and traffic for which the same are commonly used.

SECTION 14: POLICE JURISDICTION

The term "Police Jurisdiction" as herein used in this ordinance shall be construed to mean the territory without the corporate limits of said Town of Maplesville, Alabama, over which the municipal police power is exercised as provided by law.

SECTION 15:

Should any section, schedule paragraph of this ordinance be held invalid or void, it shall not affect the validity of any other section, schedule or provision hereof, which is not in itself void or invalid.
