Each year fire insurance companies shall pay \$4.00		

on each \$100 and major fraction thereof of the gross premiums returned by cancellation provided that the new companies shall pay a flat minimum license of \$10 on which there will be an adjustment on the above basis at the expiration of the year.

All license shall be due from Insurance Companies under this Ordinance and payable on or by the first day of March, and failure to pay same or failure to furnish the statement required by Section 738 or 739 of Title 37 of the Code of Alabama of 1940, shall subject any company & its agents doing business without a license to the punishment hereinafter provided as in other business without a license.
